UPE Convention highlights

- <u>Presentation of the ABACUS Award</u>. UPE is pleased to announce the presence of *Dr. Alan Kay*, recipient of the 2012 ABACUS Award, at the 2012 UPE Convention. Dr. Kay is a Silicon Valley pioneer and visionary who is credited with the creation of the personal computer along with a wide range of related systems and applications for today's computing environments. He has received numerous awards including the Charles Draper Prize, the Kyoto Prize and the Turing Award. - UPE Chapter Reports Chapter representatives (students and chapter advisors) are encouraged to make brief presentations that summarize activities of their chapters during the past year. Council will present a \$200 cash award to each individual who volunteers to make this presentation. Each presentation will be limited to a brief three-minute report. Presenters are expected to send a one-page draft of their presentation to <u>upe@acm.org</u> no later than February 22, 2012.
- <u>Council Member Election</u> An election to fill a UPE Executive Council vacancy will be held during the 2012 UPE Convention. Candidates for this position must be present at the Convention and each candidate is expected to make a brief speech prior to the election. UPE Executive Council Members serve without pay but may be reimbursed for UPE-related expenses including travel to new chapter installations and other Council-approved UPE activities, including two council meetings each year. Each council member serves a 5-year term and must be an active member of a UPE Chapter. Applications (cover letter and detailed resume/academic vitae) must be sent to <u>upe@acm.org</u> and received no later than February 18, 2012.
- **UPE-Sponsored Reception at the 2012 SIGCSE Symposium** UPE will sponsor a reception for all student volunteers at the 2012 SIGCSE Symposium. This reception will be held on Friday, March 2, 2012 at the Raleigh Marriott Hotel.
